Dear Copeville SUD Customer,

The COPEVILLE SUD water system PWS ID 0430029 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) of the Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and **report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.**

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination. This violation occurred in the monitoring period of October 2020 – December 2020 (Fourth Quarter of 2020). We are taking the following actions to address this issue: **Filing the appropriate Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report with the TCEQ.**

Please share this information with all People who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartment, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

Your water quality was never compromised, the above Violation resulted from a failure to file the appropriate report with the TCEQ. This is not a boil water notice, there is no need to boil your water. A copy of this letter will be posted to our website www.copevillewater.com and in the water office.
